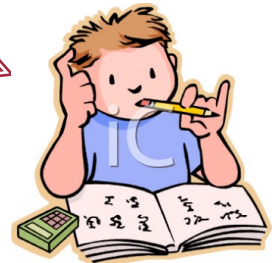
Super Learners!!
