Please note: Children will be wearing school uniform every day. We will provide your child with a Red Waterproof jacket and Black SWSF rucksack which they will wear every day.

Nightdress or pyjamas

Slippers (appropriate & safe designs only, please) or Flip-flops

Washbag, toothbrush/paste, **hairbrush & comb** – these are essential for those with longer hair, boys too, please

Towel

Hair bands – long hair must be tied back

NO hair gel or jewellery, please.

NO spray deodorant or hairspray (this is important as it can affect those with asthma. Any spray cans will be detained by the teachers until the end of the trip).

A 'lipsalve' or similar for dry lips (this is important).

Suncream – preferably the sort which needs to be applied only once a day

Changes of school clothes ie: a clean white polo shirt for each day and a spare sweatshirt (s)

Spare underwear & socks for 4 days

One pair of spare comfortable shoes suitable for walking & activities

Pocket money – no more than £20, in small denominations and in a small named purse, please (to be kept in their day-bag)

Refillable (sturdy) plastic water bottle

NO extra food (ie sweets/biscuits) in suitcases, please. We will provide all the snacks the children may need.

EQUIPMENT



A book and small game would be useful for quiet times.

Children can bring cameras (the sort which can only be used for taking photographs, not a mobile phone with a camera facility, please) labelled with name & telephone number. This will be totally your child's responsibility. **Don't forget chargers! Do ensure there's enough memory on digital cameras for the trip.**

Children must **not** bring mobile phones or **any** electronic devices with them (i-pods, DS or any hand-held game devices) to avoid loss, breakage or other complications.
