


Literacy

Fiction: Friend or Foe by Michael Morpurgo. We will write a playscript for a chapter of the book. We will identify the key features of a playscript and think about the speech for the main characters.

Non-Fiction: We will write a newspaper article based on our study of Friend or Foe. We will revise the features of a newspaper and write an article about the Germans being discovered in Devon.

Poetry: We will be studying syllabic poems such as Cinquains using the poem The Evacuee by Arthur. E King

Grammar: This half term we will be focusing on the use of conjunctions, as well as paragraphing and speech.

History and Geography

We will create a timeline of the events from the First World War to present day and think about how many countries are needed for it to be considered a 'world war'. We will discover which countries were involved in the second world war and where their allegiance lay and consider 'who wins a war?'



Maths



We will be covering the 4 themes of the new curriculum which are:

Place value – Looking at one, tens, hundreds, thousands and ten thousands.

Rounding and Estimating – Using a number line to aid rounding visually. Estimation based on rounding as a tool for checking answers.

Division – Factors. A given number is divided by a factor.

Multiplicative Reasoning – Multiples. Multiplying two whole numbers together.

Weekly tables tests and regular mental arithmetic tests will also feature in our maths learning.



PE

This term the children will develop their skills through invasion games, starting with Tag Rugby. They will continue to have their weekly swimming sessions at Tiverton Swimming Pool.

Science ~

Changing Sound: We will learn about sound waves and how they travel to our ear and cause vibrations, which we hear as sound. To help us with this we will learn about the structure of the ear and then think about the pitch and tone of the sound that we are hearing. We will then apply what we have learned to think about the noise from the Blitz and try to think how we could make the sound quieter.
