#### **The class structure for September will be as follows:**


## School Improvement Lead

We are pleased to announce that Mr Devereaux has been appointed a new position in school, that of School Improvement Lead across Key Stage 2. Working closely with the EYFS lead and Key Stage 1 teacher, his responsibilities will cover all areas of the school day, including timetabling and lunchtimes.
