Writing: We will be focusing on a short film called 'Alma', in which children write a 3rd person dual narrative and include a 1st person account from the perspective of the doll.

We will then focus on the book 'Who let the Gods out' by Maz Evans. The children will rewrite the latter part of the story from the perspective of a different character.

Spelling: We will be following the spelling shed programme, with spellings being issued online.

Maths:

Year 5 will be studying shape, including angles, followed by position and direction.

Year 6 will be revising before SATs, followed by maths investigations.
