





How can you encourage and extend your child's learning at home?

Play dough is a great activity to do at home with your little ones, it's builds strength in their hands, which they need for later skills like writing. Other activities such as pegging out the washing or doing up buttons on a coat or cardigan can also help to build these muscles.

Reading together, this can be you sharing a book by reading to your little one, or encouraging them to read to you, get them to tell you what they think is happening in the story, what can they see and notice on the page

Independence
